Sub: Procurement of cement by DRDAs/Blocks for developmental works for the year 2009-10.

Ref: This Department Letter No.20113/PR, dated 20.6.09.


Madam/Sir,

It has come to the notice of Government that in some districts doubts have arisen regarding payment to the cement companies, Tender Process, unloading charges etc.

Hence, it has been decided by Govt. that the following points should be taken into account while procuring cement by the districts.

- a) The cost of Tender paper will be maximum Rs.100/- (Rupees one hundred) only and the tender will be floated by the DRDA only and opened in the same office.
- b) Payment to the cement companies will be made by the B.D.Os through E-Payment/RTGS (Real Time Gross Settlement) in order to save delay. However, where the facilities are not available, then the A/c Payee Demand Draft favouring the respective company payable at Bhubaneswar only, will be made with intimation to the company's office located in Bhubaneswar.
- c) Regarding unloading of the materials, the BDOs will take necessary steps for unloading the materials at the Block Headquarters. Re.1/- per bag be deducted from the cement price of the companies towards unloading charges e.g. if the cement price is Rs.250/- per bag, the payment will be made @ Rs.249/- per bag and Re.1/- may be retained by the BDOs for meeting the unloading expenditure.
- d) The BDOs will confirm about the quantity of cement supplied by the companies and the balance quantity to be supplied every month and send a copy to the concerned companies to maintain transparency.
